BRANDER 2017 SAUVIGNON BLANC, LOS OLIVOS DISTRICT

The Sauvignon Blanc is sourced from our own estate vineyard in Los Olivos as well as a number of other carefully farmed vineyards with the Los Olivos AVA. We are also celebrating our 41st year of harvest with this vintage.

Cases Produced: 12,000

Composition: 96% Sauvignon Blanc, 2% Pinot Grigio, 1% Semillon, 1% Riesling

Vineyard Sources: Brander Estate, Mesa Verde, Tierra Alta, Buttonwood, Coquelicot, La Presa, Roblar, and Giff's

Harvest Dates: August 18th – September 23rd, 2017

Chemistry: Average Brix: 23.6 Average pH: 3.35

Winemaking: The grapes were harvested by hand just as each individual vineyard achieved its perfect balance of flavor, ripeness, and acidity. Every lot of grapes was 100% destemmed, then gently pressed into stainless steel tanks as well as some neutral oak (5%), and inoculated with yeast.
